Position Overview

Santa Ynez Valley Family School is seeking a talented and inspired elementary teacher for our multi-age classrooms. We currently have one K/1 co-teaching position open for the 2025/2026 school year.

A position at SYV Family School is an opportunity to grow as a teacher/researcher in a supportive and active community. This position requires a person who is detail oriented, child-centered, has a sense of humor, and most of all, is able to work in a team. It is important to have a deep understanding of the developmental norms of the elementary age student.

The teacher will have the opportunity to work in a collegial, collaborative environment where content is limited only by the imagination. Student progress will be measured using learning continuums in math, reading and writing as well as a social/emotional learning rubric. SYV Family School is currently using Bridges into Mathematics, Phono-graphix reading skills and Lucy Calkins Reading and Writing Workshop as the foundations of our program. Prior experience with specific curriculum is not required for consideration of the position. At SYV Family School, teachers provide recess duties and meet regularly as a staff to ensure a positive and productive school environment.

Primary Responsibilities

- Plan and implement lessons in reading, writing, mathematics
- Provide direct instruction in Social Skills, within the classroom and outside on the yard. This includes conflict resolution skills, appreciation of differences among students and mindfulness as a means of knowing oneself.
- Design and implement science curriculum that focuses on the diversity of sciences through hands-on labs, engagement of systems thinking, application of environmental stewardship, and integration of campus and community resources
- Design and implement a social studies curriculum that centers on cultural competency, global awareness, and multiple perspectives.
- Work with an assistant teacher and Director of Student Services to meet the needs of the various academic, emotional, and social needs of the students.
- Use multiple forms of assessments to gauge each student's progress.
- Plan and implement lessons, activities, and practices that promote The SYV Family School's Mission and Values.
- Teach students as a class, in small groups, and one-on-one
- Help to tailor classroom activities to the developmental needs of each child
- Document and discuss student's progress with colleagues, families, counselors, students, and administrators
- Construct the classroom and school environment, in collaboration with the students, to foster a culture of belonging, inclusion, and authenticity
- Provide constant supervision of the students; take care of their health & safety needs
- Demonstrated commitment to equity, diversity, and inclusion of people and programs



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- Participate actively in other aspects of the student experience and school functioning: chaperoning trips and events, serving on committees, participating in fundraising events, and developing new programs at the school
- Develop relationships, partner with, and serve as point of contact for families to provide information and relevant resources
- Genuine interest and excitement in working with students and a desire to support their learning, explorations and aspirations

Position Qualifications

- Bachelor degree or degree plus Credential
- Experience working with young students
- Strong interest in childhood education and desire to work with young students
- Commitment to promoting diversity, equity, and inclusion in classroom culture and curriculum
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- A desire to learn by doing and to learn with and from others
- A desire to teach collaboratively
- Flexibility and creativity in working in a dynamic environment where new ideas, mistakes, and iteration are embraced.
- A profound openness to feedback and improvement, modeling lifelong learning of practice as well as subject area.
- A desire to collaborate with diverse groups in a way that builds partnerships, trust, and growth.

Compensation

The salary range for this position has \$54,600 to \$71,822 starting salary depending on education (BA vs. BA + Credential) and experience. We offer a benefits package to full time employees that includes medical, dental, 403b retirement plan, matching on 403b, and partial tuition remission.
