

## Common 'a-e' Sound Pictures

This lesson is intended to offer the child practice reading and writing advanced code words. Tell the child that the words all have the sound 'a-e' in them. Explain that the sound 'a-e' is shown in the words in one of the four ways represented in the bottom box. Invite the child to read the first word and then have her map the word in the correct column. When mapping words, the child should say each sound, as she writes the sound picture (letter or letters that represent that sound). Continue on through each word.
